Excitement is building ahead of the opening of MJ: the Musical in London's famous West End theatre district on 6 March with the original Broadway cast member Myles Frost starring in his Tony Award-winning role as Dangerous era MJ. Also posted on Instagram was video footage of Myles reunited with MJ movement specialists Rich + Tone in preparation for the London performances. "They always carry the passion and intention of Michael with them everywhere they go," Myles said. Tickets can currently be booked for the evening and matinee shows through the official website.

. Biopic filming in LA causes a social media stir

Photographs of Jaafar Jackson in the role of his real-life uncle Michael Jackson for the *Michael* biopic have been causing a stir amongst fans and the media. Shooting in locations in Los Angeles, Jaafar has seen made up to look like Thriller era Michael and was depicted as MJ from his Dangerous tour in an official image shared by Michael's official online account and shared by Michael's son Prince who wrote: "This project has had so many special moments for me and everyone involved. This photo was taken by my dad's concert photographer @kevinmazur who was there for my dad's last rehearsal and Jaafar's first performance." Colman Domingo and Nia Long as Joseph and Katherine Jackson have also been seen on set with Jaafar. Another cast member was announced this month with Top Gun: Maverick actor Miles Teller taking on the role of John Branca.

Legal update on Robson/Safechuck cases.

Thanks to MJJ Repository we have a comprehensive update, including copies of court documents from the Robson and Safechuck cases, including the changes to representation on both sides, which for the Michael Jackson companies (i.e. the MJ Estate) now includes both Tom Mesereau and Susan Yu who successfully defended Michael in 2005 and who have past experience of both Wade and James before they changed their stories. The MJ defence team no longer objects to the consolidation of the cases due to the similarities in witnesses and claims. The Robson/Safechuck lawyers have notified of anticipated delays because of intending to subpoena "reluctant and international parties." MJJ Repository also notes that Wade and James "specifically note a willingness to conduct mediation, common in pre-trial settlements." So much for it not being about the money. As expected, the MJ defence team did not indicate any desire for mediation or other alternative resolutions. MJJ Repository is continuing to share new, complete episodes of the E! News 2005 trial reenactments on YouTube on a regular basis. "These reenactments coupled with the actual trial transcripts that will be made available in an enhanced format offer a very good picture of what the 2005 trial consisted of and why Michael Jackson was fully exonerated..." Sony buys stake in Michael's music catalogue

Last month Billboard reported that the Sony Music Group has purchased a half share of Michael's publishing and recording masters catalogue. It is estimated that Sony will pay something in the order US\$600 million for its stake in Mijac which has been valued between 1.2 and 1.5 billion US dollars. Sony's deal with the MJ Estate does not include royalties from the Broadway play and other theatrical productions featuring Michael's music. Billboard also notes his increased popularity on streaming platforms. "Sales and streams of Jackson's music grew steadily from 1.07 million album equivalent units in 2020 to 1.47 million in 2023 — up 37% over those three years — according to Luminate. That outpaced the overall U.S. music market for album consumption units, which grew 22.9% during that time period. Outside the United States, Jackson is arguably even more popular. In 2023, consumption of his music grew 38.3% to 6.5 billion on-demand streams, up from 4.7 billion streams in 2021." The article suggests that with the release of the Michael biopic next year, streams and sales of Michael's music will increase.
